


EXAMPLE: CD Rack

Qty.	Part Name	Finished Size	Rough Cut Size (always add one inch)
2	long side A	20"	21"
3	short side B	5 ½"	6 ½"

Construction Steps:

- 1. Assemble all of your pieces on the table before applying any glue and make sure everything fits correctly.
- 2. Use a nail jig to draw nailing lines along the edges of each piece of wood you will be nailing through
- 3. Start all nails along the nailing lines. Be careful not to go too deep and make sure the nails are straight.
- 4. Apply glue to the edges of the pieces you will be nailing into. Wipe off any drips immediately!
- 5. Start by nailing from one end and continue across the piece. Straighten any cup in the wood as you go.
- 6. Use a countersink to set the nails slightly (1/8") below the surface of the wood.
- 7. Fill all nail holes, cracks or chips with wood putty.
- 8. Sand all surfaces and remove all pencil marks.
- 9. Stain your project to seal and protect it. (optional)
